



EAA Chapter 902—Mt. Hood Chapter Air Academy Scholarship Application

Overview: The Experimental Aircraft Association conducts exciting and educational aviation summer camps in Oshkosh, Wisconsin for kids ages 12 through 17. Each camp is one week long.

The 2006 schedule is as follows:

Ages 12-13, June 15 –June 19 and June 21-25

Ages 14-15, June 27- July 3 and July 8-14

Ages 16-17, July 17-26 and July 28-August 6

A portion of the July 28-August 6 session occurs during the largest airshow in the world, located on the same airport as the camp.

Attendees are fully supervised from the time they arrive until they are placed on transportation home. All meals are provided and kids live in modern dormitories.

Each year, **EAA Chapter 902** sponsors one lucky child for the EAA Air Academy. Sponsorship consists of paying the child's tuition to the Air Academy. Transportation to Oshkosh, Wisconsin is the responsibility of the parents.

EAA Chapter 902 Scholarship Qualifications:

Flight Experience: The applicant must have been flown as a Young Eagle.

Age: 12 through 17 at the time of the camp. Children who are 11 years old now may apply as long as they will be 12 by the time of the camp. *Some preference will be given to older applicants but this does not exclude younger applicants.*

Chapter Participation: The Young Eagle selected will be expected to make a 10-15 minute presentation at a chapter meeting about his or her Air Academy experience after returning from the Academy.

Two part application process: Part 1 consists of the following questionnaire and any letters of recommendation the applicant submits. Chapter members will screen Part 1 documents and select some applicants for Part 2, which will be an interview. One lucky child will be selected from among those interviewed. The chapter decision is final. The winner will be notified by telephone and will be listed in the following month's newsletter, www.eaa902.org
